

## Demographics

### Population: Components of Change

Trend: The components of population change in Leon County in the last decade (2000-2010) changed considerably in comparison with the 1990-2000 time period. The percentage of Leon County's population growth associated with net migration dropped from 67.1% in 2000 to 56.1% in 2010. It is estimated that since the 2010 Census, 65% of Leon County's population growth is attributable to net natural increase (total births less total deaths).
