

Trend: Leon County's population increased by 36,035 residents between the 2000 and 2010 Census. More than 85% of the population growth in Leon County between 2000 and 2010 occurred within the City of Tallahassee while 15% of the growth was in Unincorporated Leon County. In comparison, between 1990 and 2000, 45% of the population growth occurred in Unincorporated Leon County.
