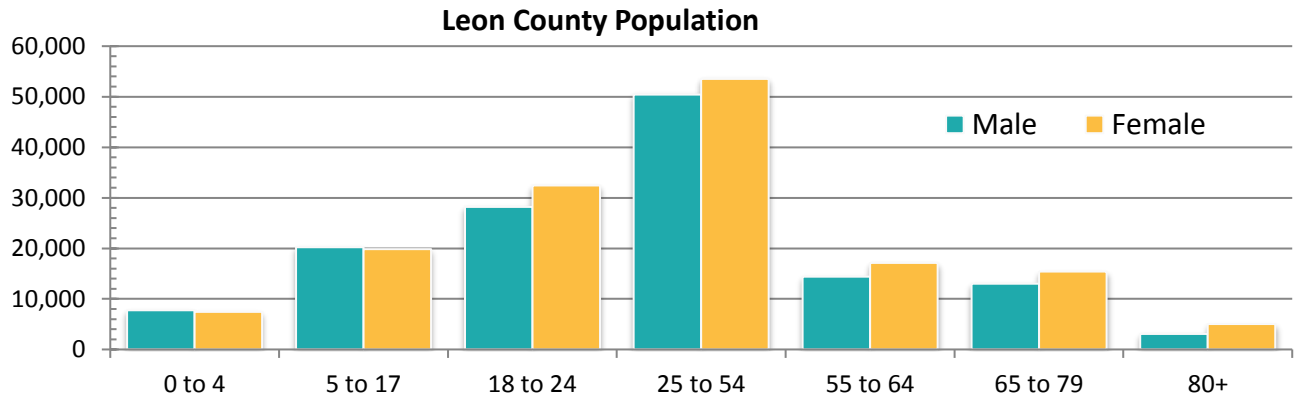


Trend: Leon County has the second highest percentage of population between the ages of 18 and 24 in the state at 21.1% (behind Alachua County) and the second smallest percentage aged 65 and older at 12.7% (after Union County) in the State of Florida.
