

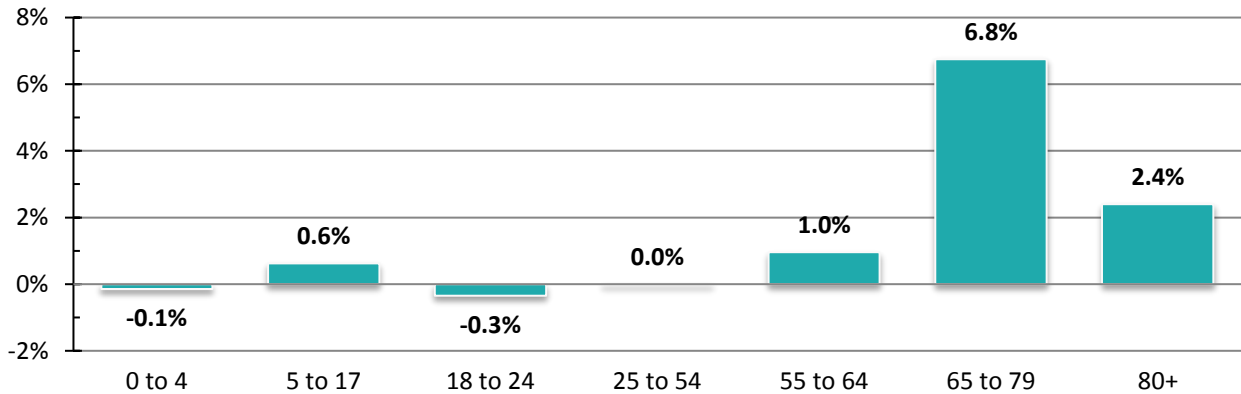
Trend: Although the 65-79 age group represents 9.5% of Leon County's total population, it is the fastest growing age group, growing at an annual rate of nearly 7% per year during 2010-2017.
