

Trend: Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) analyze and plan how money is used by businesses, nonprofit organizations, governments, and individuals. CPAs perform vital functions in economic development by preparing financial statements, evaluating investments, performing cost analyses, and detecting fraud. Of the nearly 800 active CPAs in the Tallahassee MSA, 57% have 20 years of experience or more, compared to about 44% statewide.
