

Trend: Non-agricultural jobs increased by about 1,900 in 2025 compared to 2024, with the largest gains in Professional and Business Services (1,100), Financial Activities (500), Education & Health Services (200), and Mining, Logging, and Construction (200). Job losses in 2025 included Information (-400), Other Services (-100), and Federal Government (-100).
