

Trend: Non-agricultural jobs increased by about 5,200 in 2024 compared to 2023, with the largest gains in State Government (1,600), Trade, Transportation & Utilities (1,200), and Professional and Business Services (1,000). Job losses in 2024 included Leisure & Hospitality and Information (loss of 100 jobs each).
