

Trend: Total non-farm employment for the Tallahassee MSA (not seasonally adjusted) in 2022 was 193,000, up 4.4% from 2021 (net increase of around 8,200 jobs). Total private employment was up 6.7% (gain of 8,400 jobs) in 2022 while government employment was down -0.3% over the year (loss of 200 jobs).
