Recent TSC & Lively Graduates Employed in Leon County by the next Fall

Trend: "Graduate Retention" is not easy to define. Higher education enrollment is driven by State, national, and international recruitment rather than by local labor market needs. The number of graduates and the skills they graduate with may not necessarily match the needs of Tallahassee's labor market. In the 2023/24 academic year, 3,092 graduates completed degrees at TSC and 1,137 at Lively. Graduate retention was 33.6% for TSC and 25.3% for Lively, with 21% of TSC recent graduates and 13% of Lively recent graduates full-time employed in Leon County by Fall 2024.


