Trend: The average household size decreased slightly in Leon County, from 2.35 persons per household in 2010 to 2.29 persons per household in 2020. In Leon County, the percentage of family households is higher in the unincorporated areas while the percentage of non-family households and one-person households is highest in the City of Tallahassee.
