Leon County Crime Rate

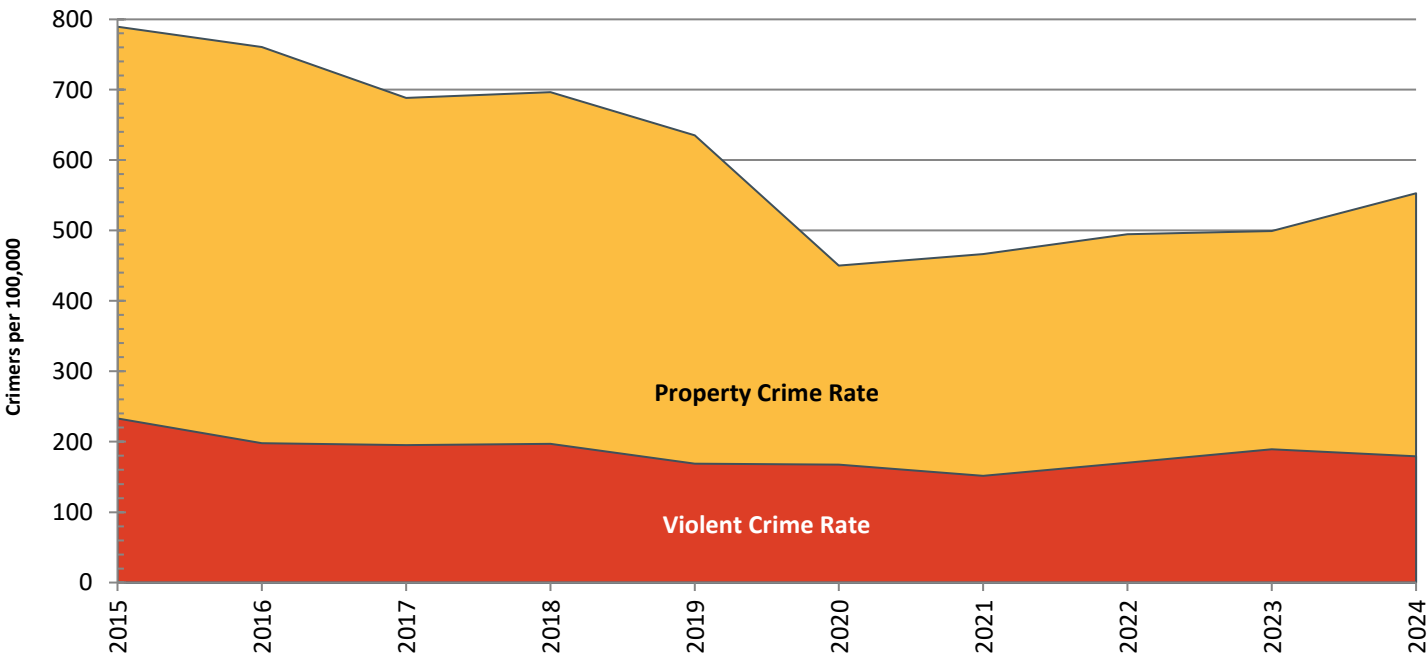
Trend: On a per capita basis, the overall frequency of crime in Leon County has fallen over the past decade. The index crime rate in 2024 was 28% lower than in 2015, with property crimes down 30% and violent crimes down 23% in 2024 compared to 2015.

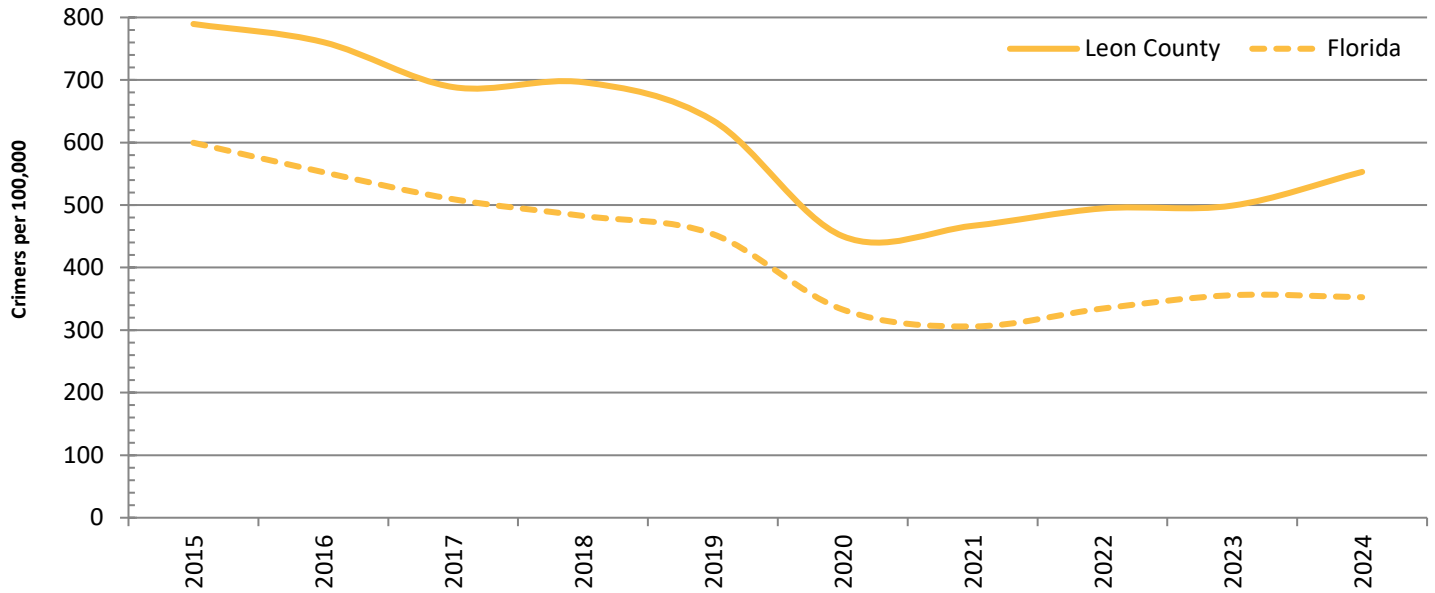
