Origins of FSU and FAMU Students (Fall 2025)

Trend: About 79% of FSU and FAMU students are Florida residents, with the Tallahassee metro area accounting for 13.4%. Broward, Miami-Dade, Hillsborough, Palm Beach, and Orange counties together account for 31% of students. About 15% of students are from another state, and 6% from another country.
