
Origins of FSU and FAMU Students (Fall 2022)

Trend: About 78-79% of FSU and FAMU students are Florida residents, with the Tallahassee metro area accounting for about 12%. Broward, Miami-Dade, Hillsborough, Palm Beach, and Orange counties together account for 33% of students. About 15% of students are from another state, and nearly 6% from another country.
