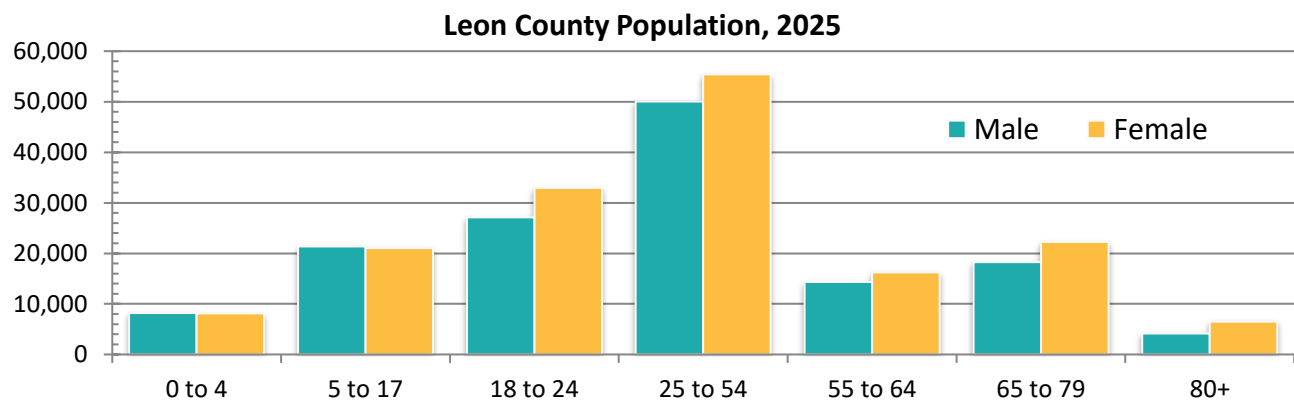


Trend: Leon County has the second highest percentage of population between the ages of 18 and 24 in the state at 20.7% (just behind Alachua County) and the sixth smallest percentage aged 65 and older at 15.1% (after Orange, Liberty, Osceola, Union, and Hillsborough counties) in the State of Florida.
