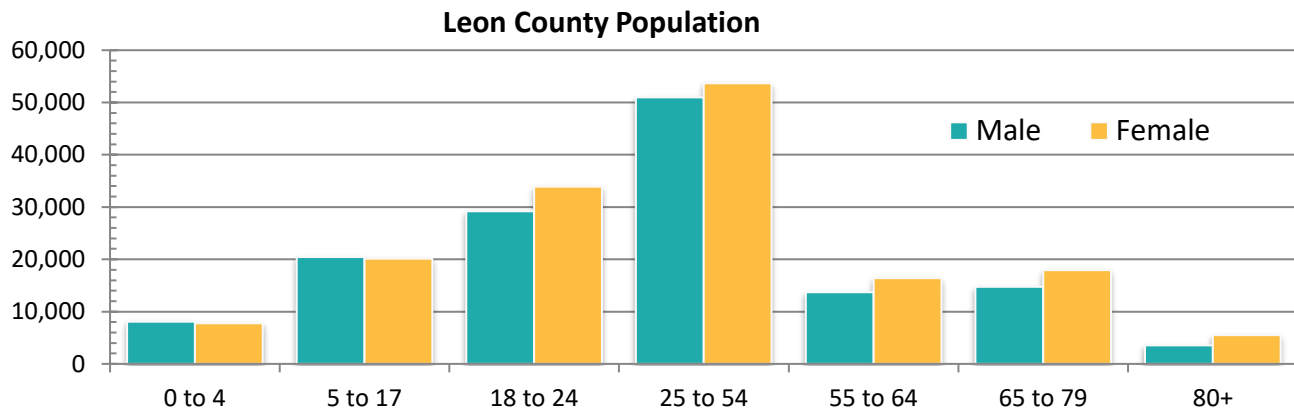


Trend: Leon County has the second highest percentage of population between the ages of 18 and 24 in the state at 20.9% (behind Alachua County) and the fifth smallest percentage aged 65 and older at 14% (after Orange, Liberty, Union, and Osceola counties) in the State of Florida.
