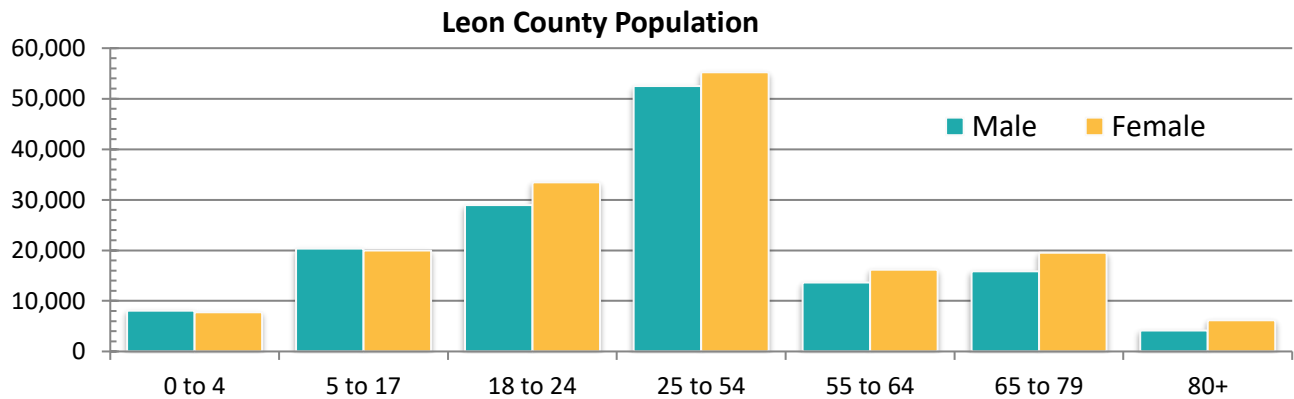


Trend: Leon County has the second highest percentage of population between the ages of 18 and 24 in the state at 20.7% (just behind Alachua County) and the fourth smallest percentage aged 65 and older at 14.7% (after Orange, Liberty, and Osceola counties) in the State of Florida.
