Trend: The population of the Tallahassee MSA (Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon and Wakulla Counties) was estimated at 393,189 in 2022, up 2.3% from 2020. The Tallahassee MSA's annual rate of growth in the 2010s was about 0.5%, compared with 1.4% during the decade of the 2000s.
