

Trend: Professional Engineers (PEs) have an essential role in a community's economic development and redevelopment. Their education, experience, and professional obligations for protecting public health and safety place them in the vanguard of innovation for public infrastructure and private-sector development. Of the nearly 800 PEs reported in the Tallahassee metro area, 50% have 20 years of experience or more, compared to only 32% among all Florida PEs.
